

From the South: Come in on Hwy 280 (Victory Drive), continue thru Ft. Benning area into Columbus. At the intersection of Hwy 280 (Victory Drive & Hwy 27 N (Veterans Pkwy) (Civic Center will be on your left) turn right onto Veterans Pkwy. Continue until 8th Street. Turn left on 8th Street and continue to Trade Center. Follow signs for Trade Center parking.

From the North: Take I-85 South to Columbus. Take Exit 10 (J. R. Allen Parkway) off of I-185 South. The sign at Exit 10 says: "To Phenix City and Montgomery, AL". Take Exit 1 off of J. R. Allen Parkway; this is the Downtown/2nd Avenue Exit. Stay on 2nd Avenue until you come to 8th Street; turn right onto 8th Street and continue to the Trade Center. Follow signs for Trade Center parking.
